

Important information for all arrivals in Bulgaria

03 June 2021

Until 31.07.2021 the new regulations for entry into the Republic of Bulgaria, issued by the Minister of Health, are in force.

Persons arriving from the following countries are temporarily not allowed to enter the territory of the Republic of Bulgaria: **Republic of India, People's Republic of Bangladesh, Nepal, Republic of the Union of Myanmar, Kingdom of Bhutan, Democratic Socialist Republic of Sri Lanka, Islamic Republic of Pakistan, Republic of Maldives, Federative Republic of Brazil and countries and territories of Africa.**

Exception from the above-mentioned countries: **Arab Republic of Egypt, People's Democratic Republic of Algeria, Republic of Tunisia, Kingdom of Morocco, Republic of Mali, Republic of the Niger, Republic of Chad, Republic of the Sudan, State of Eritrea, Federal Democratic Republic of Ethiopia, Federal Republic of Somalia, Central African Republic, Gabonese Republic, Republic of the Congo, Federal Republic of Nigeria, Republic of Benin, Togolese Republic, Republic of Côte d'Ivoire, Republic of Liberia, Republic of Sierra Leone, Republic of the Gambia, Republic of Senegal, Burkina Faso, Republic of South Sudan, Republic of Guinea, Republic of Guinea-Bissau and Republic of Madagascar, Republic of Cabo Verde, Canary Islands, Union of the Comoros, Autonomous Region of Madeira, Republic of Mauritius, Department of Mayotte, Réunion, Democratic Republic of São Tomé and Príncipe, Saint Helena, Republic of Seychelles.**

People who according to the order are allowed to enter the territory of Bulgaria may do so by providing **one of the following documents**:

- Document for a **completed full vaccination** against Covid-19, at least 14 days before the trip;
- For **people recovered from Covid-19** for the period from the 15th to the 180th day before the trip: a document showing a positive result from a polymerase chain reaction (PCR) test or a rapid antigen test for Covid-19;
- **For citizens from Bulgaria, EU, Schengen Area (including the Republic of San Marino, Principality of Andorra, Principality of Monaco and the Vatican City State), United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland, Commonwealth of Australia, Canada, United States of America, Japan, New Zealand, People's Republic of China, Republic of Rwanda, Republic of Korea, Kingdom of Thailand, Republic of Tunisia, Oriental Republic of Uruguay, United Arab Emirates, Georgia, Ukraine, Republic of North Macedonia, Republic of Serbia, Republic of Albania, Republic of Kosovo, Bosnia and Herzegovina, Montenegro, Republic of Moldova, Russian Federation, State of Israel, State of Kuwait, Republic of Belarus and the Republic of Turkey** described in the order, including members of their families, **except with one of the above** documents may enter the country with a **negative** result of PCR test for coronavirus, made not earlier than 72 hours before arrival **or** a negative rapid **antigen** test, made not earlier than 48 hours before entering the country.

Bulgarian citizens and those with the status of permanent, long-term or continuous residence in the country, **who do not provide a document for a negative PCR test**, are placed **under a 10-day**

quarantine. It is possible to reduce the quarantine upon provision of a **negative PCR or rapid antigen test performed within 24 hours of entry.**
